EVENT INFORMATION

Winners of the Fred Perry Championships finals will receive:

- One-year Fred Perry clothing supply – exclusive to 2020 winners only, not available to purchase online or in-store.
- A £1,000 tennis grant.
- A specially commissioned medal (for winners and runners-up).

All participants receive:

- Regional Qualifying Events: All players will receive their own unique Fred Perry sweatband.
- Finals Event: All players will receive their own Fred Perry training top, sweatband, and black champagne tennis balls.

Entries will close on the 25th August 2020 for the Regional Qualifying Events and the 29th August 2020 for the Finals Event. Withdrawal deadline for all events is the 31st August 2020.

Players should only enter one age group in the Finals Event (all events will be played concurrently). If any player is entered into more than one age group at the closing deadline, the referee will only accept one entry from the player at her discretion. The top 5 ranked players entering the Finals Event will be directly accepted and should withdraw from any Regional Qualifying Event they have entered.

The winner of each Regional Qualifying Event will qualify to play in the Finals Event. Any Qualifier not already entered into the Finals event will be entered manually and sent an invoice for the entry fee on confirmation that they wish to play in the Finals Event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Please read the Fred Perry Championships Terms & Conditions and Covid-19 Guidelines for further detailed information.

- The health and safety of the players, their family, and anybody else on site is of the highest priority and as such the tournament will follow and enforce LTA Covid-19 regulations and guidelines. (Please visit lta.org.uk/coronavirus for more information).
- Current Covid-19 guidelines allows for each player to attend the event with one parent/guardian non-participant in order to adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Surfaces at each venue may vary.
- All matches will be photographed, and the 8 Finals at the Finals Event will be live streamed on Fred Perry social channels.
- All events will consist of an 8 player draw for both boys and girls in each age group. The Regional Qualifying Events will be a Compass Draw. The Finals Event will be an Elimination Draw with a Compulsory Consolation.

- The Finals Event draw will comprise of 5 direct acceptances (i.e. the 5 highest ranked entrants) and the winner of each Regional Qualifying Event. In the event of any player qualifying for the Finals Event not taking up their place, the place will be allocated to the player at the top of the Finals Event reserve list.
- Scoring in the Regional Qualifying Events will be FAST4 (compass draws of 8). The Finals Event will be 2 sets and a Match Tie Break replacing the 3rd set. The Compulsory Consolation at the Finals Event will be played using FAST4 scoring.
