We have more great news! The Council has granted us permission (finally!) to install floodlights for courts 4-6. We are so pleased about this and hope that work will start soon.

Latest Improvements

All 6 courts have now been professionally cleaned and are ready for action. To maintain the courts' condition for as long as possible, we ask that they are dragged after every use when the weather is dry. Check out our handy 'how to' video on our website! If it is wet and windy, please remove wet leaves and debris from the trees by court six. It is better to use courts 4-6 over and above courts 1-3 as they are younger and we wish to prolong their life as long as we can.

We are also pleased to confirm that after a great deal of hard work and negotiation by Ben Scandrett, floodlights will be added to courts 4-6. This is a project that we have wanted to complete for a very long time and now that permission has been granted, we hope that work will start soon. Fully floodlit courts will allow more members to play for longer which we will all appreciate after this summer's play was curtailed. Great news!
